Project: Non-slip Machine Mat

Supplies

- (1) 21 inch wide by 20 inch long front fabric
- (1) 21 inch wide by 20 inch long backing fabric
- (1) 20 inch wide by 19 inch long batting

I cut my batting smaller to eliminate bulk in the seam allowances. The seam allowances will be 1/2 inch.

binding to go around mat

- (1) 16 inch wide by 6 inches long non-slip shelf liner

Directions

- Step 1: layer and quilt fabrics-I center the batting between the back and front fabrics. (remember, we are eliminating bulk in the seams.
- Step 2: bind the mat
- Step 3: turn up 4 inches from the bottom of the bound mat to make the pockets. Anchor the pocket on each side of mat.
- Step 4: divide pocket piece into segments and stitch to mat.
- Step 5: place non-slip product 3 inches down from top on the back of the mat and center product between sides. Sew down.

MAT IS FINISHED.

Go wild with color and have fun with this project.

Quilting with your embroidery machine would also work nicely.
