## QUILT SHOW WINNERS

Wanda Wallace, 2014 Quilt Show Chairman, asked each committee chair to give a brief report on their area and thanked everyone for their hard work and participation in our 15th show. The show was a success. Attendance was approximately 1500. The highest attendance was on Friday, Sunday had the least attendance. A total of 9,526 tickets were sold on the raffle quilt. Betty Bingham and Paula Jones each sold over 500 tickets. Dianne McLendon won the quilt. Three PBQ members each entered eight quilts (the maximum number allowed). They were Joe Bingham, Jo-Ann Evans and Juliann Smith.

Barbara Peters reported that only 60% of Pine Belt Quilters worked on the show. We need to increase that number. Those who did not participate missed something special. The next show will be October 6, 7 and 8 of 2016. Plan ahead to join in the fun.

Juliann Smith took pictures of the entries in the show and has put together a CD. It is

available for \$10.70 at Stewart's Camera on Hardy Street.

Ellen Cox Snippet: Ellen showed us a new use for an old product. She says that you can use bridal aisle fabric rather than paper for foundation piecing. It is very thin and does not need to be removed from your block. (It is about as thick as Pellon's light weight interfacing.) It can even be ironed onto freezer paper and run through your printer. It comes in 100 foot rolls and is 24 inches wide, plenty to be shared by several people. That's a lot of foundation piecing. It is available in the bridal section at Hobby Lobby.
