The deadline to enter a quilt in the show is August 15. The deadline for early registration (and a discount) is August 1. It's not too early to enter!

Betty Reid discussed the duties of volunteers for the quilt show.

Admission ticket sales, ticket taker, registration/information table, raffle quilt table, Boutique, Silent Auction, door prizes, White Glove Hostess, floaters, Southern Fiber Arts Exhibit White Glove Hostess, and lectures.

Barb Peters will be scheduling times to work at the show. Let her know when you would like to work.

Help is needed the week of the show.

Monday, Oct. 1, quilts will be received, checked in, and placed on tables in categories.

Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday, Oct 1, 2, 3, quilts will be judged. Volunteers needed are holders and scribes.

Wednesday & Thursday, Oct. 3 & 4, ribbons will be placed on quilts, remove tables and place in exhibit hall, assist with hanging the quilts, boutique and silent auction items will be brought in and set up, Southern Fiber Arts exhibit hung, raffle quilt and table, and registration table set up.

After the show, every PBQ member is asked to please help with taking down quilts and preparing them to go back to the owners.

Advertise the raffle quilt and turn your raffle ticket stubs and money in to Kaye Christensen each month. **Each member needs to sell at least 20 tickets.**

Turn your money and business information for ads for the show catalog in to Joe or Betty Bingham. Martha Ginn has a receipt form she can email you if you need it when you sell an ad.

Silent Auction items need to be turned in to Betty Allen by August.

Boutique items are needed and can be turned in to Shirley Wiltshire. She has a Pinterest board if you need ideas, and will take scraps to be sold, 2 1/2" & up.
