## Color Theory

Susan Mogan spoke on the vast and complex subject of color theory for quilters. Among a great deal of color information, she told how value and color work together in your quilt and will give you depth. She gave tips for finding a color scheme and values by looking at color cards in the paint section, pictures in magazines, Mother Nature, and the color dots on selveges of fabric. We made color wheels in the workshop the following day and mixed paint to get tints, tones, and shades as well as choosing color schemes using our color wheels.
