We enjoyed our speaker and teacher Diane Knott from Cumming, GA. She presented "Scrap Quilt Secrets" and brought numerous beautiful quilts to show us. Our workshop, which was a lot of fun, was held at Westminster Presbyterian Church. We started a quilt making no waste half-square triangles. She showed us how to cut the triangles using any kind of ruler. We also got to take a tour of the gorgeous sanctuary thanks to Janeil Harris and listen to a recording of her husband playing the organ.

Snippet

Ellen Cox presented us with a snippet of how to keep your rulers from slipping. It is a can of Odif Grippy Non-slip Coating which cost around \$10. You can also use it on your hangers or doormats for no more slipping!

Boutique

Immediately after the April meeting will be our Boutique Workshop. Barbara Peters will teach us how to make a no-slip sewing machine foot pedal holder. You will need your sewing machine, no slip shelf liner, a fat quarter, thread, rotary cutter and mat and other sewing notions.
