2020 Quilt Challenge Update

The 2020 quilt challenge completion date has been moved to March 2021. If you haven't started on yours, this will give you a few extra months to make one. A Few of my Favorite Things represents things that you love. ABC as easy as 123. A is for applique. Include at least 1 applique technique representing something your love. You may use raw edge, needle turn, fusible, etc., any type you choose. B is for block and may be as simple as a nine patch or elaborate as English paper piecing. Include at least 2 of your favorite blocks. C is for color. Include your 3 favorite colors. You may use variations of your colors and may add black, white, or gray. C can also stand for couching if you want to try that! Not a requirement but it is allowed. Minimum size is 40" x 40" wall hanging up to 60" x 72" lap/throw quilt.
